



GPRS / GSM SETTINGS

To activate the GPRS / GSM settings please follow the following procedure:

1. Double tap the touch screen to take the sWaP out of sleep mode.
(if the screen saver mode has been selected)
2. Press the menu button on the bottom left hand side of the sWaP
3. This will now take you to the ICON selection menu. (6 icons displayed)
4. Select the 'WAP' icon (round world shape)
5. This will now take you into the WAP menu system
6. Select option 3 (DATA ACCOUNT)
7. Select option 1 (GSM DATA)
8. Select a free Account ie Account 8 or 9
9. You should now be in the EDIT menu system
10. In account name input the network provider name ie. Orange, o2, Vodaphone, T-Mobile etc.
11. You can do this by using the EDIT option on the bottom left hand side on the touch screen.
12. Once you have done this press the Option button on the display.
13. Now use option 1 (Done)
14. Select Option 2 (NUMBER)
15. Input the GSM dial up number.

26. Scroll down to speed.
27. Select 9.6Kps.
28. Scroll to DNS.

30. Select DONE.
31. When the SAVE option appears select YES.

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32. Go back to the Data Account menu and select option 2 (GPRS)
33. Select a blank account ie Account 8 or 9
34. Select option 1 Account name.
35. Use the EDIT option and input data relevant to your network provider ie o2 gprs.
36. Once data has been input click Option and then Done.
37. Select APN and press EDIT.
38. Select from the following (relating to your network provider and contract type)

Virgin pay and go: normal

44. Click the DONE option and then when the Save option appears use the option YES.

45. Go back to the main WAP menu.

46. Select WAP (option 2)

47. Scroll down to SETTINGS (option 6).

48. Select EDIT PROFILE (option 1)

49. Select Account 8 or 9

50. Select option 2 EDIT Profile.

51. Select RENAME PROFILE (option 1)

52. Use the EDIT option and name the profile ie o2.

53. Use OPTION and select Done once this has been completed.

54. In the EDIT option select HOMEPAGE and edit.

56. Use option 3 GPRS / GSM.
57. Select the account names you setup earlier ie O2 gprs and o2
58. Use the OK selector to confirm.
59. In the EDIT menu select Connection TYPE.
60. Use option1 WAP and press OK
61. This will now take you to another screen.
62. Input the data required
