



## TO INPUT MMS SETTINGS:

Press the **Menu** Button

Select the **ENVELOPE** icon (messaging)

Select option **2** (MMS)

Scroll Down to **Message Settings** and select

Scroll down to **SERVER PROFILE** and select.

Choose a Profile which has is not being used ie : **Profile 9**

Select the **EDIT PROFILE** option (no 2)

Select **Rename profile** and press the EDIT Button. Type in the Name of the provider you are using such as O2 MMS.

Press the **option** button and select **DONE**.

Select **HOMEPAGE** and input the data below according to your network provider.

Then select **Option** and **DONE**.

Scroll to **Data Account** and Select **GPRS**. Select the GPRS setting which corresponds to your network provider ie O2 GPRS.

Press **OK**

Select Connection Type and select **HTTP** and then press **OK**.

Select Option and then Done



Select Password and edit and input the data according to your network provider.

O2 password

VODAPHONE wap

ORANGE multimedia

VIRGIN (leave blank)

TESCO password

Select done

Now test your settings by send and receiving an MMS Message.
